International Relations/Foreign Policy

- **Strengthen the U.S. alliance with Greece – a trusted, reliable NATO ally – a pillar of democracy, stability**
 - Invest in the U.S.–Greece relations across all silos, especially in defense and security. Support F-35s to Greece.
 - Protect Greece's sovereignty. Turkey's frequent provocative violations must stop. Oppose F-16s and kits to Turkey.
 - Maintaining Greece in the United States' Visa Waiver Program is in the U.S.'s national security interest.
- **Secure religious freedom and protection for the Ecumenical Patriarchate – the world's oldest Christian Church**
 - Urge Turkey to respect the rights & religious freedoms of Ecumenical Patriarchate and all religious minorities.
 - Call for the historic Orthodox Seminary at Halki to be reopened.
 - Call for Turkish authorities to restore the status of Hagia Sophia—a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- **End the 49-year illegal occupation of the Republic of Cyprus — a European Union member & U.S. Strategic Partner**
 - Back a just, viable solution where all Cypriots can enjoy democratic values & human rights.
 - **CBM**: Call for the removal of 40,000 illegal Turkish occupation troops from Cyprus.
 - **H.Res.263** | Make the Cyprus issue a top foreign policy priority of the Administration.
 - U.S. policy affirms Cyprus' sovereign right to explore energy findings within its exclusive economic zone (EEZ).
 - Support Cyprus' entry into the U.S. Visa Waiver Program (VWP)

Strengthen Investments that Strengthen Our Society & Security

We understand it is a challenging budgetary environment. However, we seek to ensure proper federal funding levels for the following **cost-effective, lifesaving, or job creating** programs that impact our community service programs and enhance our nation's security:

- **HUD Section 202 Housing for Elderly Program**: AHEPA/DOP combined sponsor **87 communities** spanning 19 states.
 - **FY24 Ask**: Expand the supply of affordable housing for the elderly: **Support** Senate's FY24 THUD appropriations bill.
 - Enhance the Service Coordinator program to ensure all 202 communities have a service coordinator to provide residents with the ability to age in place and live independently, thus saving taxpayer dollars.
 - **S.1557/H.R.3238** | Strengthen the bipartisan-backed Affordable Housing Tax Credit, a model public-private partnership.
- **Domestic Violence Programs**: The DOP is a national sponsor of two domestic violence centers.
 - **FY24 Ask**: At minimum, the President's request of \$1.04 billion for VAWA programs and a Crime Victims Fund cap that is set at \$2 billion without any transfers to programs not authorized under the VOCA statute.
 - **H.R.2604** | Reauthorize and provide robust funding for Family Violence Prevention and Services Act (**FVPSA**) programs.
- **Foreign Aid FY24 Ask**: Support \$1.8 million for Greece's International Military Education & Training (**IMET**) program.
- **NIH**: Maximize investment in medical research. It improves Americans' lives and drives the economy. Of specific importance:
 - **Thalassemia (Cooley's Anemia)** research programs at **NHLBI & NIDDK**; and cancer research at **NCI**.
- **HHS/ACL**: Maximize funding for **Older Americans Act** programs, including nutrition services (i.e., Meals on Wheels).

Cultural/Historical/Educational

- **H.Res.510** | Call for the restoration of the Parthenon with the return of the Parthenon Marbles. The Parthenon is an important monument to our **American heritage** because it is a hallmark of Western Civilization and Democracy.
- **S.1329/H.R.2803 | Armenian Genocide Education Act** | To direct the Librarian of Congress to carry out activities to support Armenian Genocide education programs (Armenian Genocide as defined in bill to include "Greeks.")
